**JUDGMENT ENTRY APPOINTING EMERGENCY GUARDIANSHIP
AND SETTING HEARING ON CONTINUATION OF EMERGENCY
GUARDIANSHIP FOR INCOMPETENT PERSON**

20____, on an application for appointment of an emergency guardianship.

Based upon the medical evidence and/or report of _____,
the Court finds that the ward is an incompetent person in need of an emergency guardianship
and that immediate action is required to prevent significant injury or harm to the person (and
estate) of the incompetent.

The Court hereby appoints _____, as
the emergency guardian of the person (and estate) of the ward with the authority to make
decisions for the best interests of the ward regarding medical care and treatment.

This Order shall remain in effect for a period of seventy-two hours. The Court hereby
sets this matter for hearing whether to extend the emergency order on the _____ day of

It is further ordered that a copy of this Order be served upon the ward and interested
parties forthwith.

This Order has been granted ex parte for the reasons that a medical emergency exists,
that the ward is unable to make his/her own decisions regarding medical care and treatment,
and that immediate action is required at this time to prevent significant injury or harm to the
ward.

Notice was given to ward's next of kin by telephone, fax, or other means.

Notice was not given to ward's next of kin because next of kin could not be reached.

The next of kin were unknown or could not be ascertained prior to the hearing.
